Plugged In! has reached out to several of the valiant members of the U.S. Military who play Electric Football to find out how our popular game fits into their demanding lives.

The shockwaves felt across the Pacific Ocean at Fort Shaffer on the island of Oahu, Hawaii, have not been from any recent volcanic eruptions—but rather from some thrilling Electric Football games, thanks to Sergeant Rodney Taylor.

Originally from Midland, PA, Sgt. Taylor picked up an Electric Football game at a Toys R US near the base about a year ago and started a real buzz by playing the game he treasured as a kid.

Taylor admitted that interest started out slowly until two more EFL players, Sgt. Thomas Duval

GETTING CONNECTED WITH...TYRONE WILLINGHAM



Coach Willingham

Second year Notre Dame head football coach Tyrone Willingham became an idol to all EFL coaches last December when he announced on ESPN—upon receiving the prestigious George Munger College Coach of the Year Award—that his inspiration for becoming a coach was the Electric Football game he played as a youth. The "lessons" have really paid off, as his Fighting Irish went 10-3 in 2002, following a disappointing 5-6 record the year before.

An outstanding quarterback and flanker at Michigan State, Willingham has been coaching football for 25 years. A native of Jacksonville, NC, he spent seven years as head coach at Stanford before taking the Notre Dame post.

Willingham spent time on the phone with PLUGGED IN! just before the start of the 2003 season, and here are highlights of that conversation:

PLUGGED IN! (PI!): What was your motivation for mentioning Electric Football on national TV when you won the Coach of the Year Award? Tyrone Willingham (TW): I was asked at the time, "Did you always know you wanted to be a coach," and I responded, no...but also said that in looking back at my childhood, things that happened or things I did hook.

looking back at my childhood, things that happened or things I did back then, <u>now</u> appear to have pointed me in that direction. I said that I received an Electric Football game as a Christmas present when I was in my early teens, and we played with it a lot. That certainly was one motivation of mine.

PI!: Did you have siblings when you were growing up?

TW: Yes, I was the oldest of four. I have one brother, Jerome, and two sisters, Joyce and Gail.

PI!: With whom did you usually play?

TW: I usually played with my brother.

PI!: But we understand you also had an unusual way of utilizing the figures.

TW: Yes, I did. Often I would play by myself, setting up the players in different offensive formations on the EFL board, and going through different

plays to see how each player should react. Most times I would not even turn on the electricity, just moving the figures by hand. Looking back now, that sure was the beginning of my coaching enthusiasm.

PI! Did you and your brother also play real football?

TW: Yes, we did. We started out as young kids in the midget leagues, then went on to junior high football and I went on to high school and college football at Michigan State University.

PI! What other types of sports board games did you and your brother play growing up?

TW: To our knowledge, there were no other football games other than Electric Football. It was the game of choice back then—much like youngsters today like to play computer games. When you had an Electric Football set back then, you were something special.

PI:If you were going to try to introduce Electric Football to teenagers today—since, of course, it is still available to them—what do you think you would tell them?

TW: The difference is that the Electric Football game allowed the child to have more imagination. Obviously, with the more electronic and computer games, everything is more laid out for the children. But with Electric Football you have to employ your imagination—and that is a wonderful thing to stimulate in any learning environment.

PI! How does the social aspect of Electric Football compare with today's electronic and computer games in your opinion?

TW: Electric Football allows for the growth of the individual in terms of social adjustment—not just communication skills or speaking with someone else—but also for setting rules and having a particular procedural aspect added to your play. I think the socialization of the individual is enhanced because of the nature of the game.

PI! Do you have any children?

TW: I have two teenage daughters and one teenage son..

P!! We would like to send a game to you to play with your children. TW: That would be great—I know they will love it.

PI! Good luck this year coach.

TW: Thanks. And good luck to all the EFL Coaches out there. ■

Notes McGhee: "Military work is very challenging, the responsibilities are immense at times and you cannot beat the camaraderie and friendships that are generated by the military experience. <u>/madlabber/main.html.</u> "Electric Football is like a moving chess board to me, and to square off with the mind of your opponent is a real high for me. I enjoy learning from other coaches and sharing ideas with the coaches I've met. There are some very talented people in this hobby!"

One of these talented people can be found at Tinker Air Force Base in Oklahoma—USAF Major Ralph B. "Hawk" Hawkins, one of the Electric Football community's most dedicated solitaire coaches. Hawk, a native of Colorado Springs, CO, told Plugged In! that he has been playing EF since 1969 and has remained loyal to the game throughout his 28 years in the Air Force.

Hawkins considers Electric football "a great escape from the 'real world'—it allows one to

recharge his batteries and escape into his own 'world' of sports that you can summon upon at any given moment."

Another Air Force officer, Chief Master Sergeant James Wallrich, has carried his 32 years of playing Electric Football around the world during his 20 years in the military. Originally from Ashton, IA, and currently stationed at Randolph Air Force Base in San Antonio, TX, Wallrich remembers buying a SBXXI game in 1988 while in Ansbach, Germany, and thinks that today's video games do not even compare to Electric Football.

"For anyone who has played or watches football, this game is definitely a means of relaxation and strategy—whereas video games (like Play Station) just create anxiety and require little tactical skill," stated Wallrich. "This game fits well into a military lifestyle. I think Miggle could really make some headway by getting boards to deployed troops—I'm sure this game would be a big hit in the recreation tents and an opportunity to reintroduce the game to a lot of former players."

"We agree with James," stated EFL Commissioner Michael Landsman. "Now turn to page two of this Newsletter and see 'EFL Unplugged!'—finally, every service man and woman in all parts of the world can enjoy Electric Football."

"The people in our league are more interested in positively promoting EF and our league for further growth than always winning," Davis notes.




