## **2005 EFL CONVENTION SPARKS SUPERLATIVES**

If anyone attending this year's 11th Annual Official Electric Football Super Bowl & Convention

thought they heard more of a buzz at this year's event at the Embassy Suites Hotel in Pittsburgh than in events past, they were right!

According to convention coordinator Ira H. Silverman of Silverman Media&Marketing Group, about 400% more tournament games were played on the opening day of the 2005 EFL Super Bowl Convention than at any Convention beforehand—thus giving rise to more buzzing, as well as more cheering, elation, excitement and disappointment than on any previous Saturday at a Miggle EFL Convention.

Yes, after a decade that saw the Miggle Super Bowl tournament grow from a four or five coach event in its infancy to a huge single elimination competition, Delayne and Michael Landsman decided last summer to give the coaches what they were really clamoring for at the Miggle Convention—a format that allowed them to play far more games against many more opponents.

The plan that the Landsmans and a special Tournament Organizing Committee comprised of Ron Bell, Aaron Johnson, Frank Johnson and Mark Klingbeil came up with was instantly applauded by all—a Round-Robin format in which the field was seeded into four eight-coach divisions that were then divided into the Dirk Thomas and Doc Smeby Conferences, with each coach playing every other coach in that division once.

From there, the four division winners in each Conference met in semifinal and Conference Championship games, with the two Conference winners going head to head in the Super Bowl of Electric Football 11 on Sunday afternoon, Jan. 30, 2005.

## NORBERT REVELS SHOCKS EFL WORLD WITH 2005 SUPER BOWL WIN

Norbert Revels (Hamtramick, MI, Great Lakes EFL), making his first-ever appearance at Miggle's Official Super Bowl Weekend (held this year at the Embassy Suites Pittsburgh/International Airport Hotel), powered through the most difficult, challenging and grueling tournament format yet to earn the prestigious Miggle Trophy as champion of Miggle's Super Bowl of Electric Football 11.

To get to the Super Bowl game, Coach Revels, a 40-year-old butcher, had to defeat seven opponents in a round-robin competition, then **Brian Perry** (River Rouge, MI, Detroit EFL), 20-0, in his Conference semi-final; three-time Miggle Super Bowl Champion **Ron Bell** (New Orleans, LA, New Orleans EFL), 24-6, in his Conference title game; and finally two-time Miggle EFL Super Bowl defending champion **Edgar Downs** (Gary, IN, Midwest EFL) in the title tilt.

The festive Super Bowl Pre-Game Show began with a heartfelt rendition of The Star Spangled Banner by guest vocalist **Carolyn Niederlander**, followed by introductions of the opposing Coaches by Convention MC **Ira H. Silverman**. The micro-

phone was then turned over to the incomparable "broadcasting team" of Ken "Sir Talkalot" Allen and "Let Me Be Frank With You" Johnson, who again handled play-by-play and commentary duties, respectively, in a flawless manner.

Following the coin toss by Official Super Bowl Referee Jim Bushofsky of the Big 10, the coaches took over the action. Right from the first play from scrimmage—which resulted in an 80-yard TD run—Coach Revels showed a game filled with finesse,

Before closing, I would like to take this opportunity to wish all of you and all of our brave and vigilant troops around the world a safe and healthy year, and to always keep that "buzz" going.



## IN TRIBUTE TO OUR GOOD

The entire EFL Community lost a great friend, colleague, advisor, mentor and calming and uniting influence recently when news came from overseas that Kurt "Doc" Smeby had passed away from diabetes-related complications.





Doc's wife with the sad news, the chatboard on the Miggle Toys website was filled with posts from coaches all over the country who wanted to share their memories and reflections of a man who dedicated his life to sharing his love for the game of football with adults and youth all over the globe.

EFL coaches and fans were first introduced to the remarkable Doc Smeby in the Spring 1997 issue of PLUGGED IN!, shortly after he traveled from England to Chicago to attend the 3rd Annual Miggle EFL Convention. We devoted space in both the Spring and Fall 1997 issues of our Newsletter to Doc, describing him as "a long-time Electric Football fan who currently is head coach of the Irish National American Football Team."

On June 23 of that year, Doc was inducted into the Minor Pro Football Hall of Fame in Canton, Ohio, in recognition of his "tremendous work in international football over the years."

The next seven years saw Doc spread his knowledge of American football to additional areas of Europe while, at the same time, remain a staunch supporter of Electric Football as both a teaching tool for his neophyte players and as a hobby and pastime in his personal life.

Mel Blount

On the website of the Pro Football Hall of Fame, it says about this month's interview subject, a 1989 Hall of Fame inductee: "Mel Blount was the prototype cornerback of his era and a major reason why the Steelers were the dominant team of the National Football League in the 1970s'

While the bio does acknowledge his "ideal size, speed and quickness, plus his toughness and mental ability," it fails to mention that what really sets Mel Blount apart from his peers is his heart.

The heart of a champion led to his playing 14 seasons in the NFL, all with the Pittsburgh Steelers (missing only one game along the way), being named the league's Defensive MVP in 1975, earning All-Pro honors four times and being chosen for five

Pro Bowl Games. He also intercepted 57 passes, recovered 13 opponent fumbles and was a leader on four Steelers Super Bowl Championship teams.

But it's Mel Blount's heart away from the football field that makes him a superstar today. At the same time as he was stepping into the Hall of Fame in Canton, OH, he also was launching the Mel Blount Youth Center in Washington County, PA, a 300 acre facility that provides short-term emergency shelter, as well as long-term residential placement, for young at-risk men.

Mel Blount took some time out recently between meetings and planning a major fundraising event to talk with PLUGGED IN! about Electric Football, youngsters and his Youth Home. Here are highlights of that conversation:

Plugged In!: I understand you did not have access to Electric Football when you were growing up. Tell us about that. Mel Blount: I was born in 1948, and if you're a history buff you are familiar with the plight of black people in America at that time. We didn't have running water, indoor plumbing or electricity. It wasn't until 1967, when I came home from college, that we got our first indoor toilet. We didn't have the things that most kids have today, but now, when I'm older and look back at those days, I realize we had a beautiful life.

#### ETTING CONNECTED WITH...MEL BLOUNT

PI!: Can you tell us about some of the things you are teaching the youngsters who are part of your Youth Home program?

MB: The reason I set up our program on a farm is because I wanted kids to have a strong work ethic. I wanted them to understand that work doesn't hurt you. It teaches you values, helps you with morals, gives you good self-esteem and teaches you to respect life. Today, the kids learn quickly to understand that life is precious and you've got to respect it and cherish it.

PII: We all know that Electric Football is the type of game that is much more sociable and hands-on than more technologically designed games. What are your thoughts about Electric Football in today's society? MB: I think the beauty of Electric Football games is that there is a lot of interaction for kids and their parents or their grandparents—or it could be their aunt or uncle or their siblings. I think it's good that Electric Football has a human element involved, whereas when you have a computer game, you're just dealing with the computer and a mouse. So I think it's something that is really an advantage for families who are trying to get everyone to do things together.

PII: What kinds of lessons can you teach kids about life from games like Electric Football?

MB: I think we want to teach kids that they should try as hard as they can when playing any sport or game, but they must understand that they are not going to win every time. If you can learn something positive while you're competing—even if it is something you learn in a game that you lose—then you're a better person for it. Something that concerns me right now, however, is that there is so much individualism in sports today. So I would like to teach kids that you have to work together...that it's not about me, it's about the team, what's best for the team and what's best for everybody.

PI!: How do you plan to use the six Electric Football Games that Miggle Toys donated to your Youth Home at the Convention this January? MB: We're holding them for the summer, as we want the boys to learn how to play the game properly before we just put the boards out. The Pittsburgh Electric Football League has volunteered to come down to the facility and give the kids a clinic so they can learn the right way to play the game right from the start. It should be a great time for them!

PI!: What message would you like to leave us with today? MB: I invite all PLUGGED IN! readers to visit our website at www.melblount.com. We also want people to know that we are working to build better lives for young people by building character and developing young people into productive citizens. We welcome everyone to visit us at the Mel Blount Youth Center when they are in western Pennsylvania and to support us in any ways they wish.

#### Loss of a Friend

In addition to the passing of Kurt "Doc" Smeby (see story on page 2 of this issue), the EFL world lost another popular coach since the publication of the Fall 2004 issue of PLUGGED IN!

David Bradley Fox, one of the original coaches of the Philadelphia EFL in 1997, passed away on Nov. 16, 2004, after living his entire life in Philadelphia. His days always seemed to be enveloped with "giving," and he was clearly well respected for his honesty and loyalty and for being a person who truly knew the meaning of

friendship and family.

A graduate of Temple University, David was recently employed by the Defenders Association of Philadelphia as a child advocate social worker.

Fellow Philly EFLer Myron Evans told PLUGGED IN! that David coached in the PEFL through the 1999 season, then continued his EF career with the NEFL (2000-2003), which holds its season during the spring.

"Coach Fox was always trying to upgrade the strength of his team through trades," Evans recalled, "and was known for his strong offensive and

defensive lines. Continually making his presence felt with his support for Philadelphia EF, Coach Fox was best known for his resonating voice and his signature bushy mustache."

# ELECTRIC FOOTBALL FOR LIFE: MIKE PRATT, FIRST-EVER EFL GOOD VIBRATIONS AWARD RECIPIENT

From time to time, the efforts, accomplishments and contributions of people involved with Electric Football are overlooked; their dedication and commitment go unnoticed...and certainly go unrewarded.

of Miggle Toys decided to solve this dilemma by establishing a special "Good Vibrations" Lifetime Achievement Award to recognize (as merited) individuals who have dedicated a significant portion of their lives to not just playing Electric Football, but more importantly to sharing, growing, teaching and promoting the hobby.

The "Good Vibrations" Award was unveiled at the Welcome Reception & Dinner to kick-off the 2005 Miggle Convention in Pittsburgh—and the firstever winner was **Mike Pratt** of Hollidaysburg, PA.

"Electric Football is not just a pastime for Mike," noted the Landsmans in presenting the beautiful trophy. "The love he has for this game and his fellow coaches is immense; the EFL has obviously become a part of his everyday routine. And for that, along with his many, many contributions to the EFL community, we wanted to single him out to receive our inaugural Good Vibrations Award."

When not involved in one Electric Football activity or another, Mike, 43, is pursuing his own business in custom computers that he builds and repairs. He obviously has a very patient and understanding family, which includes his wife, Melanie, son Joseph, 22, and stepson Sean, 15.

Mike spends at least an hour a day active with the hobby.

"Most of my involvement with Electric Football is not actual playing time," Mike told PLUGGED IN! "It's spent tweaking and testing bases and boards, dealing with rules and equipment issues and answering questions by phone and email from other coaches."

Mike's passion for Electric Football began around 1969, when he was seven years old. Although the initial moment is fuzzy, he recalls seeing numerous store advertisements for the product, as well as the game on the shelves of local department stores. As a huge NFL fan as a child, the idea that miniature players representing NFL teams could physically move on a field in front of him was thrilling to both his eyes and his imagination. As the years went on, and his Christmas and birthday lists grew with requests for EF sets and items, so did his fascination with the game.

Throughout his involvement with Electric Football, Mike has assisted in countless efforts to promote the game. Of high priority was the establishment of a National EF League in 2004.

Another initiative in which Mike had a prominent role this past season, along with Mark and Bill Klingbeil, was assisting Miggle in their quest for better bases. "Their market niche is unique in the respect that they have a lot of customers who just open the game, assemble it and begin playing," remarked Mike. "But they also have the hobby enthusiasts who are always going to push the performance limits of bases when they take them out of the box or bag.

"Miggle is to be congratulated and praised for their willingness to listen to those in the hobby who can offer them solutions for product improvement," applauded Mike. "To advise them on how to improve their products is the least we can do."

Always humble, always self-effacing, always helpful, always knowledgeable. Those are the qualities that have attracted a league full of friends throughout the Electric Football community to Mike Pratt. And those are some of the same traits that earned him the initial Miggle "Good Vibrations" Award earlier this year.

creativity and patience. He added a two-point conversion, and the 8-0 score stood up at half-time.

The second half was more of the same. After stopping Coach Downs to open the second half, Coach Revels took the ball with 24 minutes left in the game and put on an Electric Football exhibition that could have lit up the Pittsburgh sky in an evening blackout. In a drive that lasted more than a quarter and a half, Coach Revels ate up nearly the entire game clock utilizing a crushing ground game that culminated in a three yard touchdown run. The drive lasted so long, in fact, that Coach Downs was left with only a minute on the clock and two timeouts on the referee's score sheet.

Over the course of the entire weekend, and especially in the Super Bowl game, it was a combination of a dogged offense, a nearly impenetrable defense and awesome special teams play that helped Coach Revels' Kansas City Chiefs defeat opponent after opponent. The final score in the Super Bowl, Chiefs-14—St. Louis Rams-0, gave the Michigan native his first (but probably not last) Miggle Super Bowl title.



## ROB DALMASSE NAMED 2005 EFL COACH OF THE YEAR IN HIS HOMETOWN

One could imagine the elation on the face of Edgewood, PA's Rob Dalmasse when his name was announced at this year's Miggle Convention as the winner of the 2005 EFL Coach of the Year Award.

The honor obviously was exciting, but the experience was particularly momentous because Rob's wife, Bonnie, and other family members, fellow coaches in the Pittsburgh Electric Football League and Rick Giugliano from the Pittsburgh Steelers were also present at the Embassy Suites Hotel in his hometown of Pittsburgh.

"It was a great privilege and a rather humbling experience to receive the award in the presence of all the talented Electric Football coaches from around the nation," Rob told PLUGGED IN!. "The fact that it happened in Pittsburgh made it all the more special."

When Rob, 42, a lab technician in the chemistry

department at Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh, got the word last year that the 11th Annual Official Electric Football Super Bowl & Convention would take place in Pittsburgh, he sprang right into action. While others might have celebrated and boasted that the Convention was coming to their hometown, Rob volunteered to do some advance scouting of the host venue. Michael and Delayne Landsman eagerly took him up on his offer, so Rob visited the Embassy Suites Hotel, spoke with management and took lots of photos—which he forwarded to the Landsmans and Ira H. Silverman, Convention coordinator.

"The ambassadorial work Rob has done for Electric Football throughout the Pittsburgh area, along with the relationships he has built with his hometown media and the Steelers," noted EFL Commissioner Michael Landsman, "were major reasons why we selected the Steel City to host this year's Convention. Rob's contributions to the game were many in 2004, and he was a most deserving Coach of the Year honoree."

Yes, 2004 was a benchmark year for Electric Football in Pittsburgh—and for Rob Dalmasse.

First, the Pittsburgh Steelers organization—for the third consecutive year—invited the Pittsburgh EFL (which consists primarily of PhD students in Carnegie Mellon's chemistry department) to host an EFL event at their Annual Fan Blitz/College Draft Day. Hordes of old and new Electric Football fans crowded around the Pittsburgh EFL booth to

see demonstrations of the game, participate in clinics and challenge the league coaches.

"As always, it was an incredible experience being a part of the Steelers family and of NFL Draft Day," Rob commented. "Who knew that Electric Football could take us to such wonderful places?"

Another destination that Electric Football made possible for Rob and his fellow coaches was Cleveland, OH, where they were invited to assist in the creation and production of an Electric Football commercial shoot for Rally's Hamburgers.

"That experience was educational and fun," said Rob, "although I learned never to check into a Cleveland hotel at 2 a.m. wearing a Pittsburgh Steelers cap!"

Completing the praises to Rob Dalmasse was Delayne Landsman, the Commissioner's wife and a member of the Award Selection Committee. "Rob's passion for Electric Football, his great attitude and his never-ending eagerness to always go the 'extra mile' made him the logical choice for 2005 EFL Coach of the Year. He is a true leader and innovator, serious, but fun-loving, at the same time."

Rob would like to send a "shout out" to John and Shawna Evans of Edgewood, PA, for sharing their breathtaking Heinz Field Stadium replica model with all Convention attendees. "They built the stadium at home and set it up near the Convention entrance," Rob stated, "and it was a HUGE hit with everyone in the crowd!"

#### 2005 EFL BREAKTHROUGH COACH OF THE YEAR: RAIDERMAN

Selecting the **2005 Breakthrough Coach of the Year** was not a difficult decision for EFL Commissioner Michael Landsman and his wife, Delayne.

According to the award's description, the *Breakthrough Coach of the Year* is an "individual whose contributions and dedication to the game of Electric Football—along with his/her playing ability, creativity and enthusiasm—had most risen from the 'local' level to the national 'stage' in the previous 12 months," according to the Landsmans.

Paul Bartels, (a.k.a. "Raiderman") of Dover, PA, fits that description perfectly. While he has been one of the country's most outstanding coaches over the past several years, as well as an outspoken advocate for the game, it was really not until 2004 when his accomplishments and contributions to the hobby as a whole earned him role model status among both children and adults.

"While Raiderman has been known around the country for years for his Electric Football involvement," Delayne Landsman told PLUGGED IN!, "it wasn't until last year, when he really made a huge commitment and effort to help unite and grow the EFL community, that his efforts made a true impact on the hobby. Raiderman was clearly the number one candidate for this award."

Not surprisingly, Paul's wife, Corbyn, and his beautiful children, Karmyn, three years old, Mya, one, and newborn son, Eli, are his biggest fans and supporters. A highly successful architectural designer, Raiderman was announced as the winner of the 2005 Breakthrough Coach of the Year at the Welcome Reception & Dinner at the 2005 EFL Convention in Pittsburgh on January 28.

"I am flattered to share the same title as Tom Ruesink, who won last year," Raiderman told PLUGGED IN! shortly after the Convention. "Also, I'm so glad that my good friend, Mike Pratt, was the first ever Good Vibrations Award winner this year. The 2005 Convention was really exciting for everyone."

Raiderman has incorporated Electric Football into other parts of his life as well. "I use it to reach out to kids who don't have a mentor or a role model. I get them involved in the game, and before too long they become pretty successful. Electric Football has been a method to draw in youngsters to a hobby that's exciting and promotes teamwork and dedication."

Raiderman assists children by creating teams for them to use, including custom painting names, numbers, chinstraps and facemasks for 26-30 man rosters. He assembles between six and 10 teams a year for youngsters to use in the Harrisburg League, which obviously consumes a great deal of this time.

"Once in a while I have to put the brushes down and work on the bases for some teams too," Raiderman said. "But most of my time is spent creating the teams. My games—and all of my Electric Football belongings—are located in my den, far away from my kids!"

There were other electrifying moments for Raiderman throughout the course of 2004, one of which being his heavy involvement along with Mike Pratt and others, in the launch of the National EF League

"The highlight of the year for me, however, was seeing my 'little brother,' Gabe (through the Big Brother program), win our College League in Harrisburg. He was only 13 at the time, and he defeated some great coaches."

Obviously, Paul Bartels' Little Brother made a major breakthrough in his EFL coaching in 2004. And the man behind this young man—Paul "Raiderman" Bartels—was such a major force in Electric Football last year that he was named Breakthrough Coach of the Year.







#### FROM MIKE PATTON, CLEVELAND:

Having majored in Electric Football instead of class work in school, I decided that after work I'd check in on this convention.

I was amazed to see so many exhibitors and fans. I was blown away with how far the hobby had come and that there were still people playing. I instantly began regretting having retired when my own kids came along. I felt like an adult who long ago gave up on Santa Claus only to find myself transported to the North Pole to Santa's Toy Shop. I never imagined so much Electric Football product and interest.

## FROM MATT WAVRA. KOKOMO, IN:

I was so excited to play in my first

Miggle tournament in South Bend, IN, a few snowy winters ago. I was thrilled that it was only two hours north of Kokomo, my hometown. I spent several days before preparing: Scripting plays, practicing my passing, kicking, etc. I came in feeling like my Colts could play with anybody, especially since the teams and bases were to be used right out of the bag.
