



For the first time in the history of the SCPCBCS National Championship Game we have 2 teams owned by different coaches and the game being played by a different coach

This is the set up that was intended when the SCPC Rules Committee decided to have a Solitaire Coaches Points Challenge Bowl Championship Series National Championship Game.

The Kansas State Wildcats of the BIG-8 League, owned and coached by David Foster, finished Season IV of the SCPC as the #1 ranked Regular Season National Champion and 3.3 Box Stock Division Champion.

The Bangalore Warhawks of the EEFLI League, owned and coached by Ray Sugg, finished Season IV of the SCPC as the #2 ranked team and second in the 3.3 Box Stock Division.

Both owner/coaches agreed to send their teams to SCPC Commissioner, Chris LeMay to play this game.

Both David Foster and Ray Sugg have had the opportunity to play for the National Championship in previous seasons of the SCPC.

In SCPC Season I, Ray's 4.0 Inclusive Division Champion 1972 Miami Dolphins were declared the National Champions after defeating his 1966 Green Bay Packers.

David's Missouri Tigers defeated his Texas Longhorns to win both the 3.3 Box Stock Division Championship and the National Championship for Season III of the SCPC.

Ray, aka "troutbum", has been participating in the SCPC since its inaugural season. David, aka "the System" and "tigers16" joined the SCPC in season 2.

It is very entertaining to follow these coaches game play through out the year as both are very good at documenting their games and posting action pics of their game play.

And that is what helps to make the SCPC the success that it has become along with all the other coaches who have participated and continue to participate in the SCPC.

For me, this year has been very challenging to be able to compete in the SCPC, so to be able to have the opportunity to play this game was very rewarding.

Thanks to Ray and David for agreeing to send their teams to my home and allowing me to coach this game.

Report



In the week leading up to the big game, preparations were being made for the arrival of the teams. Officials and Cheerleaders were there and the official TTQB's to be used during the game were practicing. This game would feature TTQB kicking, punting and passing.







The Bangalore Warhawks of the Elite Electric Football League of India was the first team to arrive making the trip from Canton, NC and the home of owner Ray Sugg.





The Kansas State Wildcats of the BIG-8 League arrive making the trip from the home of owner David Foster of Topeka ,KS.



Both teams come to this game with identical 10-0 season records. However because Kansas State plays in a 12 team league their Strength of Schedule SCPC Quality Win Bonus Points give them the # 1 Ranking in the SCPC.

The Warhawks play in an 8 team league which means they play at least 3 teams twice during the season. This lowers a team's chances of earning as many Quality Win Bonus Points as a team that faces their opponents only once during the regular season.

In the week prior to the game, both teams had the opportunity to scrimmage the Commissioner's Tennessee Titans.



# The Pre-game Analysis

Both teams are registered in the 3.3 Box Stock Division of the SCPC. To compete in the 3.3 Box Stock Division - "Players, figure and base, are used "as is out of the box". No weight may be added or removed. Minimal or no base tweaking may be done. Small details may be added such as face mask and / or chin straps that do not significantly add weight to the figure. "

The Kansas State Wildcats are Tudor regular size figures on Tudor "Invisabases". The weigh in from 1.6 grams to 2.3 grams.






The Bangalore Warhawks are Tudor 67 Big Men on Tudor Rookie and TTC convention bases. The weigh in at from 2.6 grams to 3.3 grams. This clearly gives the advantage in size, strength and speed to the Warhawks.


In reviewing the seasons of the teams, Both are run first teams featuring league leading running backs. Since the rules being used for this game allow forward progress tackling — i.e. a ball carrier is not down until his forward progress has been stopped by an opponents "tackle", he runs out of bounds, or his forward progress is reversed, Bangalore has the advantage.

The Wildcats will most likely have to abandon their running game and go to a pass first or pass on every down offense and try to control the ball and manage the clock. Since TTQB passing will be used, passing will depend on the skill and accuracy of the coach of the game.

This will be a very interesting game and hopefully one that will display the true fun and excitement of playing in a solitaire format. It will certainly be a challenge for the coach in using two teams that he is unfamiliar with and adapt them to his style of play and rule set.

Wildcats lined up to kick off, Warhawks lined up to receive...

The kick travels 48 yds to the Bangalore 17 yard line ...







... #81 Shanta receives and returns 57 yards to the Kansas St 26 and out of bounds.



Bangalore begins their first drive 1/10 from the Kansas St 26. They line up in their run left formation with #44 Lobo as the ball carrier.






Breaks out to the left ... and around the corner with good blocking ahead...








... TOUCHDOWN!!!


So the Warhawks need only one play and : 35 seconds to get on the scoreboard first and after the failed extra point attempt lead 6-0.




Lobo 26 yard run (kick failed) Bangalore 6 Kansas St 0.



Bangalore kicks off to Kansas St... 48 yards to the Kanas St 17 yard line.







#42 Sproles receives... turns towards the sideline at the 30 ... and runs out of bounds.

Kansas St starts their first drive at their own 31.







Two runs by Sproles, the first for – 6 yards and the second for -7 yards, sets up 3/23 from the Kansas St 18







QB Klien fades back and sets up to pass with WE #82 Morgan open. The pass is complete to Morgan at the Kansas St 24.





Morgan gets downfield past LB #5 Shetty but turns back upfield at his own 34 for a 16 yard gain.



With 4<sup>th</sup> and 7 from their 34, Kansas St lines up to punt having gained only a net of 3 yards on their first possession. BIG-8 League leading rusher Sproles was stopped in the backfield twice by the Warhawks defense losing a total of 13 yards.

## After a punt of 42 yards and a return of 34 yds by #68 Thiminaiah of 34 yds,







Bangalore sets up 1/10 @ Kansas St 42 in a run right formation with RB #42 Lobo as the ball carrier.



And once again Lobo breaks through the line, into the open, and carries 42 yards for another Warhawk ... TOUCHDOWN!!!!

#30 Green received the ensuing kickoff for Kansas St and returned it 45 yards to the Bangalore 30 yard line and out of bounds.









After one incomplete pass to WR Morgan, Klien connected on a pass to WR # 88 Neslon. Nelson took it the distance, 30 yards for a Wildcat TOUCHDOWN!!!.









The Conversion kick was GOOD. So the Wildcats scored on their second possession by going to the passing game and scoring on a 30 yard pass from Klien to Nelson.



Thiminaiah returned the Kansas St kickoff 35 yards from the Warhawks' 35 to the Wildcats' 30. This time the Warhawks lined up in their Wishbone formation with 1/10 from the Kansas St 30.



Lobo took the handoff from Shetty and broke through the line for another 30 yard touchdown run.









This time the extra point was GOOD!!!



1<sup>st</sup> Quarter – Bangalore 3 possessions, 3 TD's – Lobo 3 carries, 98 yds, 3 TD's

For the remainder of the first quarter, Miller returned the kickoff 5 yards with Lambu making the tackle, Klien completed a pass to Green for 30 yards and Sproles ran once for -7 yards with Thiminaiah making the tackle.




The Second Quarter saw no more scoring but the Wildcats were able to move the ball from the Bangalore 37 to the Warhawks 14 with Sproles carrying once for -6 yds and then Klien completing 2 of 4 passes for 29 yards to Nelson and Morgan.



But with 3/10 from the Bangalore 14, Klien dropped back to pass and found Morgan open but an errant pass was intercepted by the Warhawks' Shanta at the 18 and returned 13 yards to end the Wildcat drive.



## The first half ended with 3 carries by Lobo of 2, 5, and -6 yards. Score Bangalore 19 Kansas St 7



In the first half, the Bangalore Warhawks scored 3 times on 4 possessions while the Kansas St Wildcats scored once on 3 possessions.

Bangalore RB #42 Roshan Lobo carried the ball 6 times for 99 yards and 3 touchdowns.

Kansas St QB Klien was 5 of 9 passing for 105 yds, 1 touchdown, 1 interception.

The Wildcats will receive the second half kickoff. The key to the second half for Kansas State will be to control the ball and keep it out of the hands of the Warhawks' offense.

# The Second Half-3rd Qtr

After a kickoff return of 20 yards by Klien, the Wildcats began their drive from the Kansas St 40 yard line.



An incomplete pass and runs of 9 yards and 2 yards by Sproles gained a first down and moved the ball to the Bangalore 49 yard line.







Two more carries by Sproles of -6 and -4 yards ...





... sets up 3/20 from the Kansas State 41 yard line. Klien lines up in shotgun with slot receivers on both sides of the formation.



Miller and Morgan are open on the right side. Klien hits Miller for a gain of 29 yards and a first down at the Warhawks' 30.





Sproles take a handoff from Klien, finds an opening up the middle and takes it in for the TOUCHDOWN!!! The extra point failed.











This drive took 7 plays and 13:24 off the clock and moved the Wildcats to within a touchdown of the Warhawks' lead. Bangalore 19 Kansas St 13.


A kick off return of 32 yards by Shanta and a run of -1 yard by Lobo brings an end to the third quarter.





# The Final Period


The fourth quarter begins with the Warhawks leading 19 - 13 with a  $2^{nd}$  and 11 from the Bangalore 49 yard line.



The Warhawks score again on 2 plays to begin the fourth quarter. Lobo runs for 41 yards to take the ball to the Kansas St 9. Lobo then runs right and scores to take a 25 - 13 lead.

After a kick to the goal line and a 5 yard kick return by Sproles, Kansas St begins this possession from deep in their own territory with 12:05 remaining, 95 yards to go and needing a touchdown to remain in the game.



Klien completes 3 of his next five passes moving the ball from the 5 yard line to the Bangalore 39 yard line before calling a time out with 2:38 remaining in the game.


















# The 2 Minute Warning

Klien again lines up in shotgun with 3 receivers to the left of the formation.





He spots Nelson in the open but over throw the receiver.







Thiminaiah intercepts at the Bangalore 15 and returns to the 26 yards to the 41.







Shetty carries once last time for an 8 yard gain.




Warhawks in victory formation as time expires.
