Top FAQ's about Miniature Football

1) How do the players move?

The figures are placed on a base which combines to form a "player" or "athlete". The bases have "angled prongs" that respond to the electrical vibration of the field to cause movement. The manipulation of this base, called "tweaking", is how the players move around the field. Please visit our website to learn more about the science of tweaking.

2) How can I get a miniature electric football game and additional equipment today?
