Stadium Assembly Instructions

Save original carton and protective packing materials for convenient storage of parts when not in use

Assemble BASE

- 1. Center your Electric Football gameboard in an undisturbed area at least 4 feet x 5 feet.
- 2. Identify 4 curved base corners 1 and 14 straight base pieces 2 Pieces are marked on underside.
- 3. Start with a corner and connect 2 (or 5) straight pieces at one end. Proceed around gameboard and add another corner piece at the second corner. Continue with more straight pieces to the third corner, and so on, until you connect back to the first corner and close the shape.

Assemble STAIRS AND TOP

- Identify stair pieces (3)
- Starting at a corner, attach stair piece to base piece (insert tab on bottom of stair into slot on base - slide and lock in place).
- 3. Continue to attach stairs in this manner until you have
- filled all the slots on the base.

 4. Identify 4 curved top corners and 14 straight top pieces
- Top assembly is similar to base assembly, but each top piece must also slide and lock into the top of a stair piece from underneath.


Assemble CROWD

- Identify the 6 rectangular crowd pieces 4 4 triangular shaped corner pieces 5, and 4 small rectangular corner pieces 6.
- 2 Start with the small rectangular pieces, and insert one into each of the four corners. Make sure to anchor it into the corners by sliding the center slots over the corresponding slots on the stairs. Insert the end tabs into the corresponding slots on the stairs.
- 3. Next, insert the 4 triangular shaped corner pieces. Use the slots as guides to align the part on the stairs. Slide the piece into place and fold the tab behind the rectangular corner piece to hold the upper part in place
- 4. Lastly, install the rectangular crowd pieces in a similar manner. Install the short end first using the slots as guides. Refer to the image at right to see how the pieces look when installed.

NOTE: The crowd pieces can be installed prior to installing the top ring.

OPTIONS

For variety, or for easier access to field, try building stadium with end or side sections open. For example, both sides may be removed so two players can easily reach their teams. Or short end may be eliminated for an unobstructed view of the game. For use with a smaller game, use fewer sections.



Assemble LIGHTS

- 1. Identify front

 and back

 pieces of 4 light units.
- Make sure that bulb and switch are securely in place.
- 3. Insert 2 "AA" alkaline batteries (not included) as shown and snap
- front and back pieces together. Secure with screws and screwdriver provided.

 4. Insert one light into each of the 4 holes on stadium top and through notched corners


 Turn switch


 to "on" position. NOTE: Always turn lights off when not in use. Remove batteries from lights for storage.

Scoreboard Assembly

- 1. Carefully punch out scoreboard and scoring circles at perforations. Punch out holes in front of scoreboard.
- 2. Remove scoring knobs from sprue. Starting at left ("Visitors"), attach one of the 10-number circles with "L" in the center py by placing it behind the scoreboard and pushing a scoring knob through both the first ROUND hole in the scoreboard and also through the scoring circle behind. (Numbers should now be visible in first HEXAGONAL window 14). Continue to next round hole, attaching a 10-number scoring circle with "R" in center 15. Continue to "Down." Attach first 4-number scoring circle At "Quarter" attach second 4-number scoring circle Finish with remaining "L" and "R" scoring circles to finish
- 3. Fold scoreboard at center and at both sides to form triangle. Lock tabs on bottom to close.
- 4. Attach securely to top surface of stadium with double sided tape (not included).
