



GPEFL SCHAMBLE 2003

Rules

- The Scramble is a timed game.
- All coaches begin and end their games at the same time using one central clock controlled by the official timer.
- All matches will be arranged prior to start of first game
- The first coach to go on offense is determined prior to start by the flip of a coin.
- The offensive coach will have 10 minutes to run a maximum of 4 plays
- Each play begins at the 30 yard line
- There are no first downs, extra points, or field goals
- No setup of players on the board can begin till timer calls "start"
- At the end of 10 minutes when timer calls "stop" the board cannot be touched! If a
 play is in progress the board is turned off. (on a run play the yards gained at the
 stoppage are counted, on a pass play if the pass was completed before stop was
 called the yardage is recorded, if the ball has not left the passers hand when time is
 called there are no points recorded for this play)
- Defensive coaches have 20 seconds to call "set" after offensive coach calls "set" (if set is not called by the defensive coach from the time the offensive coach called set, the offense receives 20 additional points for that play and can start the board at their discretion. If the offensive coach calls an audible, the defense is given an additional 20 seconds from the time the offensive coach calls "set"
 - EX: O coach calls set and turns on 20 second timer. D coach does not call set by the time the timer goes off. (20 points awarded) O coach can begin play as soon as the timer sounds, wait for D coach to finish set or can call an audible. If an audible is called the O coach makes his changes and again calls set and starts the 20 second timer. Etc.
 - 2. D coach calls set before the 20 second timer sounds. O coach begins play at his discretion or calls an audible.
- On change of direction plays, defensive coaches <u>must</u> make their directional changes in a timely fashion. Any <u>purposeful</u> delays, as judged by the official timer, will disqualify that coach for his next series of offensive downs.
- All applicable rules of the GPEFL apply except for noted exceptions below
- The official timer has <u>all rights</u> to make changes to these rules as situations arise

Scoring

- 1 point is scored for every yard gained (Maximum per play would be 30 points)
- 20 pointed are scored in addition to the yardage points for a Touchdown (i.e.
 Offensive coach starts first play from the 30 and runs for a TD. 30 points for yards + 20 points for TD = 50 points for the first play.
- Sacks (any play stopped/tackled behind the line of scrimmage) count as 20 points for the defensive coach-no points are taken away from the offensive coach regardless of how far behind the line he was tackled
- Interceptions count as 20 points for the defensive coach
- 20 points are awarded in addition to the points scored on the play to the offense if
 defense has not called set within 20 seconds of the offensive coach calling set. NOTE:
 It is the offensive coaches responsibility to call set and start the timer. If he forgets---TO
 BAD!!!
- 50 additional points are awarded each coach who wins their game

Exceptions

- All plays will begin from the middle of the field
- Defenses are allowed a maximum of 7 men 1 yard off the line of scrimmage.
- Defenses must have 2 men 20 yards back
- All other defensive players must be at least 5 yards from the line of scrimmage
- Defense may not line up their men in an "unbalanced fashion" and will be judged according to the following rule.
 - 1. there are 3 zones
 - 2. the right zone (right sideline to nearest hashmark)
 - 3. the middle zone (hashmark to hashmark)
 - 4. the left zone (left sideline to nearest hashmark)
 - both safeties (players 20 yards back) may not be lined up together in the right zone or the left zone
 - both safeties may be lined up together in the middle zone
 - linebackers (players 5 yards from the line of scrimmage and in front of the safeties) may not have more then 2 men in right or left zone
 - the number of men lined up 1 yard off the line of scrimmage and between the tackles (down lineman) determine how many men may be lined up on the line of scrimmage.
 - 1-2 down lineman=not allowed (you must have at least 3)
 - 3 down linemen=no more then 5 men 1 yard off the LOS
 - 4 down linemen=no more then 6 men 1 yard off the LOS
 - 5 down linemen=no more then 7 men 1 yard off the LOS
 - 6 or more down linemen is not allowed
 - cornerbacks may be lined up 1-19 yards from the line of scrimmage with only I per zone and only in the right or left zone.
- Passes that are not obvious are considered incomplete.
- Tackles that are not obvious are considered not tackles.

Recommendations

- It will be very important to have more then one ball ready prior to start of play. If a ball
 is lost it is up to your discretion as to whether you take time to look for it. In between
 games we will do a ball search for any lost balls
- Be prepared
- Read and know the rules
- Play fairly
- Know the definitions of a tackle, pitch, shovel, handoff, and lateral
- HAVE FUN
- These will be fast paced action filled games so be ready and prepared.

ULTIMATE PLAYER'S CLUB ELECTRIC FOOTBALL RULES

GP-EFL Rules are to be followed except for where noted below

Formation Selection - Before a play is run, the formation of the offense and defense on a play are determined by the toss of the die and the formation & play selector chart.

Play Selection - After the selection of a formation by the offense and defense have been made, the selection of a play to be run by the offense is then determined by the toss of the die and the formation & play selector chart. After the offense has selected their play, the offense and defense may make their final adjustment of their players within the formations they have selected. After a play has been selected and before a play is run, the offense and defense may substitute players that are best suited for that play.

Audibles - The offense may only call an Audible when an option play is initially selected. The offense may #1 select a new formation and a new play, #2 select a new formation and keep the same play or #3 select a new play and keep the same formation. After the offense has selected their new formation and / or play, the offense may make their final adjustment of their players within the new formation and / or play they have selected. The defense does not get to select a new formation when an audible is called by the offense. The defense may then make three (3) final adjustments of their players. After a play has been selected and before a play is run, the offense and defense may substitute players that are best suited for that play.

Running Plays - There must be a running play by a backfield player lined up between the tackles that is at least 1 inch behind the offensive linemen. Hand offs, pitches, shovel passes, laterals or passes are not allowed on selected running plays. A change of direction may be called on a selected running play.

Passing Plays - There must be a pass attempt, lateral attempt or shovel pass attempt by the quarterback on a selected passing play. You may call a change of direction on a roll out pass play or let the quarterback scramble on a stand still pass play but there must be a pass attempt, lateral attempt or shovel pass attempt on the play before the end of the selected passing play. If the quarterback crosses the line of scrimmage, he is considered tackled at the line of scrimmage. Hand offs and pitches are not allowed on selected passing plays.

Option Plays - You have the choice to run, hand off, pitch, run reverses, shovel pass, lateral, pass or continue to run on a selected option play. You may call a change of direction on a running play and on a roll out pass play or let the quarterback scramble on a stand still pass play. You may attempt one (1) halfback pass per half on a selected option play.

VIOLATION CHART RULES

The dice are tossed at the end of each play by the Referee or Defensive coach to determine if there was a violation or fumble during the play.

REGULAR PLAYS, FIELD GOAL ATTEMPTS AND CONVERSION ATTEMPTS:

If the toss of the dice reveals a 1 - 1 Personal Foul, 2 - 2 Holding or 3 - 3 / 5 - 5 Offside, the violation will be marked off from the LOS whether the violation is on the offense or defense. If the toss of the dice reveals a 4 - 4 Fumble, then the team that recovers the fumble starts it's play 1st and 10 from the spot of the fumble at the end of the play. If the toss of the dice reveals a 6 - 6 Off - Setting, then the offense replays the down from the LOS. Any violation may be declined by the opposition (except for 4 - 4 Fumble and 6 - 6 Off - Setting). If the toss of the dice reveals a 1 - 1 Personal Foul, 2 - 2 Holding or 3 - 3 / 5 - 5 Offside violation against the offense, then the violation will be marked off half the distance to the goal line when the LOS is between the fourteen (14) yard line and the two (2) yard line of the offensive team (when applicable). If the toss of the dice reveals a 1 - 1 Personal Foul, 2 - 2 Holding or 3 - 3 / 5 - 5 Offside violation against the defense, then the violation will be marked off half the distance to the goal line when the LOS is between the fourteen (14) yard line and the two (2) yard line of the defensive team (when applicable).

KICKOFFS:

Any violation during a Kickoff will be marked off from the end of the return (except for 6 - 6 Off - Setting in which case the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from the end of the return).

If there is a Touchback during a Kickoff and the toss of the dice reveals a 1 - 1 Personal Foul, 2 - 2 Holding or 3 - 3 / 5 - 5 Offside, the violation will be marked off from the offense's twenty (20) yard line whether the violation is on the offense or defense. If there is a Touchback and the toss of the dice reveals a 4 - 4 Fumble, then the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from their own twenty (20) yard line. If there is a Touchback and the toss of the dice reveals a 6 - 6 Off - Setting, then the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from their own twenty (20) yard line.

PUNTS:

Any violation during a Punt will be marked off from the end of the return or where the football was kicked out of bounds (except for 6 - 6 Off - Setting in which case the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from the end of the return or starts it's play 1st and 10 from where the football was kicked out of bounds).

If there is a Touchback during a Punt and the toss of the dice reveals a 1 - 1 Personal Foul, 2 - 2 Holding or 3 - 3 / 5 - 5 Offside, the violation will be marked off from the offense's twenty (20) yard line whether the violation is on the offense or defense. If there is a Touchback and the toss of the dice reveals a 4 - 4 Fumble, then the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from their own twenty (20) yard line. If there is a Touchback and the toss of the dice reveals a 6 - 6 Off - Setting, then the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from their own twenty (20) yard line.

If there is a Fair Catch during a Punt and the toss of the dice reveals a 1 - 1 Personal Foul, 2 - 2 Holding or 3 - 3 / 5 - 5 Offside, the violation will be marked off from the spot of the Fair Catch whether the violation is on the offense or defense. If there is a Fair Catch and the toss of the dice reveals a 4 - 4 Fumble, then the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from the spot of the Fair Catch if they recover or the opposition starts it's play 1st and 10 on offense from the spot of the Fair Catch if they recover. If there is a Fair Catch and the toss of the dice reveals a 6 - 6 Off - Setting, then the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from the spot of the Fair Catch.

If there is a Fair Catch in the end zone during a Punt and the toss of the dice reveals a 1 - 1 Personal Foul, 2 - 2 Holding or 3 - 3 / 5 - 5 Offside, the violation will be marked off from the offense's twenty (20) yard line whether the violation is on the offense or defense. If there is a Fair Catch in the end zone and the toss of the dice reveals a 4 - 4 Fumble, then the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from their own twenty (20) yard line. If there is a Fair Catch in the end zone and the toss of the dice reveals a 6 - 6 Off - Setting, then the offense starts it's play 1st and 10 from their own twenty (20) yard line.

FUMBLED PITCH CHART RULES

The dice are tossed by the Referee or Defensive coach when the board has been switched off at the time of each pitch to determine if there was a fumbled pitch during the play.

If the toss of the dice reveals a 1 - 1 or 6 - 6 fumbled pitch out of bounds, then the offense always retains possession of the football at the spot of the fumbled pitch on the next down.

The "spot of the fumbled pitch "refers to the forward most point of the pitch man (player to receive the pitch) towards the line of scrimmage.

3.8 AP ALTERNATIVE PASSING

The rules in 3.7 LATERAL, 3.8 PASSING and 4.4 INTERCEPTIONS apply to this section except:


The offensive coach has to indicate who the intended receiver will be when the board is stopped before the die are tossed.

After it is determined how far away from the line of scrimmage the intended receiver is, the toss of the die and the Passing Chart will determined whether the pass attempt was complete, incomplete or intercepted.

If the toss of the die indicates that the pass attempt was intercepted, then the defensive coach may indicate any defender that is within two (2) inches base to base of the intended receiver to be the interceptor. If there is no defender within two (2) inches base to base of the intended receiver when the toss of the die indicates a pass attempt was intercepted, then the pass attempt is considered an incomplete pass attempt.
